
## Evidence of your Finances for STUDENT visa applications



As part of your visa application the UKVI will assess whether you have sufficient funds to study in the UK. Your visa application must demonstrate that you have either money for boarding fees or sufficient course and maintenance funds (for living costs) for the first year of your course, less any deposit paid. This will also depend on your course:



## **Example 1**

You have applied for a Foundation Diploma in Art & Design at CSVPA and have opted to stay in college accommodation.

Boarding Fees (course + accommodation) £27,540 + £14,100 = £41,640

Fees Paid

£2,500

You are required to show £41,640 - £2,500 = £39,140

## Example 2

You have applied for a 2-year Extended Diploma at CSVPA and will be staying in independent accommodation.

Course Fees £29,985

**Maintenance Funds** 

£1,334 x 9 months = £12,006

Fees Paid £2,500

You are required to show

(£29,985 + £12,006) - £2,500 = £39,491

## Example 3

You have applied for BA programme at CSVPA and have opted to stay in college accommodation. You need to show maintenance NOT accommodation

Course Fees £15,690

**Maintenance Funds** 

£1,023 x 9 months = £9,207

Fees Paid £2,500

You are required to show (£15,690 + £9,207) - £2,500 = £22,397
